CES 2024 showcased many developments shaping the future of smart home tech. The focus was on Thread's 2024 enhancement and a range of new products. Aqara's innovative releases are also exciting and include the Aqara U300 Smart Lever Lock, Aqara Border Router Smart Plug (the pioneer in integrating Thread border router capabilities), and multifunctional Aqara M3 Hub which serves as both a Matter controller and a Thread Border Router.

Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) Wind-Down

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) announced the ACP benefit program which provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet for eligible households, will stop processing new applications after Feb. 7, 2024, at 11:59 PM ET.
